


In 2001, the Agile Alliance pushed back on the tool and process-ware vendors causing a swing away from process enactment.

Integrating a spectrum of enterprise stakeholders is a challenge for a project or a process. This is easier to achieve with process enactment.

Process Definition and Enactment

Process definition and process enactment share a symbiotic relationship

Enactment is the realization of process definition

Just as we produce working software we need to produce working process


Enactment is a key component of enablement that:

- **Increases ease of adoption**
- **Prevents users reverting back to old practices / bad habits**

Through enactment process can be:

- **Measured and improved**
- **Hold Auditable and facilitate regulatory compliance (if required)**

- Process definition needs to be complemented by additional views.

Achieving Organizational Agility
